Urgent – Submission for Demerger

Local Government Minister Ron Hoenig has provided the residents, ratepayers and interested community members with the opportunity once again to submit our views on seeking to successfully and finally invoke a demerger from the current disastrous merger of Cootamundra and Gundagai Regional Council

<u>This is now or never – our</u> <u>final chance.</u>

I would ask you all - together with your friends and acquaintances to submit an extremely simple submission to the office of Local Government stating your position – hopefully supporting the demerger process. Whilst the New State Labour Government have backed away from their commitment whilst in opposition to fund demergers, the situation is now so dire that the Council recognises that a demerger even funded by the rate payers, will, in the long term be far less painful financially than if we continue together down the unequitable and undemocratic pathway we are now treading. Yes, we will have to apply for a SRV (Special Rate Variation) to achieve this demerger, but equally we will continue to apply for yearly SRV under a joint regional council (CGRC) as the most recent \$6 million deficit for 2024/2025 budget shows.

And this deficit will continue to grow with the large number of consultants being employed, lacking local representation. I urge you to help us achieve this demerger by going onto the Internet – Office of Local Government - Cootamundra Gundagai Regional Council Demerger. Follow the information- have a read if you need information and then scroll down and click on the submission form. Add your details if you wish, then, if you agree with the demerger – click yes, then elector as most people will come under that category.

If you wish to make a comment, please do so and then click submit. If you have more to say or wish to make a longer submission – feel free to submit a written submission to the postal address. **All**

submissions need to be in by Friday 10th May. Please have a say in determining your future. Nothing good at all has come from the government's whim and fantasy belief that savings of \$20 million would result after 3 years of newly merged council – however, in reality, in the 8 years of the merger, we now have lost close to \$42 million. What a disaster! Please have a chat to me if you want anything clarified - I have been a member o the Gundagai Council in Exile since it was formed 8 years ago in May 2016.
