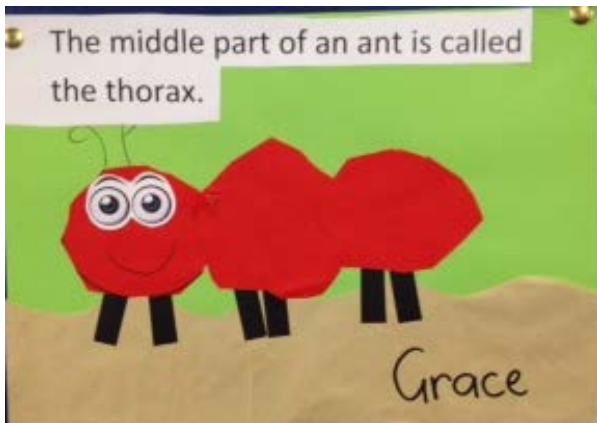

Red

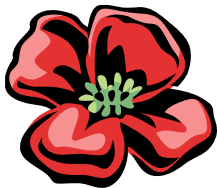
Red is the colour of the blood of men in war
